Fairly Traded Coffee—12 oz. each

Café Salvador (\$5)

A full-bodied and smooth coffee grown by small farmer cooperatives in El Salvador, a joint project with Oxfam America and Neighbor to Neighbor.

Tanzanian Jubilee (\$5)

Full-bodied and flavorful, grown by small farmers on the slopes of Mt. Kilimanjaro in Tanzania, East Africa.

Organic Mind, Body & Soul (\$6)

Our coffee purchaser's euphoric blend, lively, smooth and spicy, grown from indigenous cooperatives in Oaxaca and Chiapas, Mexico.

Hazelnut Creme (\$6)

Medium roast coffee with an enticing nutty aroma & a rich hazelnut flavor, grown by small farmer cooperatives in El Salvador.

Organic Decaf (\$7)

All the richness of our Organic Breakfast Blend, naturally decaffeinated, from small farmer co-ops in Latin America.

Bright Day Brew (\$5)

A lighter roast coffee. Balanced with a malty aroma and hints of citrus, from small farmer co-ops in Colombia and Tanzania.

Colombian CO2 Decaf (\$6)

Full-bodied and well-balanced with a rich, smooth flavor, grown by indigenous farmers in Colombia.

Organic Ethiopian (\$6)

From the Sidamo region of Ethiopia, this exotic and complex coffee has heavy body, gentle acidity and hints of vanilla, black pepper and raspberry.

French Vanilla (\$6)

Medium roast coffee with a rich vanilla flavor, grown by small farmer cooperatives in El Salvador.

Organic Breakfast Blend (\$6)

A balanced blend of light and dark roasts, full-bodied with a rich flavor, from small farmer cooperatives in Nicaragua and Peru.

Organic Colombian (\$6)

From indigenous cooperatives in the Caldas region of Colombia. Balanced, with light acidity.

Organic Love Buzz (\$6)

Sweet, sultry and smooth with an unexpected bite and a lasting finish. Fairly traded from small farmer cooperatives in Latin America.

Toffee Caramel (\$6)

Two deliciously different flavors, combined to produce a candy-like sweetness and buttery finish, from small farmer cooperatives in El Salvador.

Hazelnut Creme Decaf (\$7)

Medium roast coffee with nutty aroma & creamy rich hazelnut flavor, from small farmer co-ops in El Salvador, naturally decaffeinated.

All coffees are drip-grind (that is, ground for your standard automatic coffee maker.) Percolator grind (e.g., for our large coffee urns) and whole-bean packages are available at a small discount, but must be purchased in bulk. Fairly Traded Organic Tea—25 tea bags per box

Irish Breakfast Tea (\$3)

Black tea with a distinctive, bright flavor, blended from tea of the Sahyadri Farmers Consortium in the state of Kerala in Southern India and garden tea from Tea Promoters of India in northern India.

Green Tea (\$3)

Made from premium unfermented Darjeeling tea cultivated by small-scale growers in India. Green tea has become very popular for its antioxidant qualities.

English Breakfast Tea (\$3)

Blend of malty Assam and crisp Darjeeling teas from tea gardens and independent small-scale growers in India. A refreshing tea that can be enjoyed throughout the day.

Rooibos Tea—caffeine-free (\$3)

From the Wupperthal Tea Association in South Africa, this distinct herbal plant grown by African farmers for over a century produces a rich, fruity caffeine-free tea that contains antioxidants.

Earl Grey Tea (\$3)

From the finest tips and buds of pekoe tea, grown by small-scale growers in Darjeeling, India, this tea is infused with natural bergamot oil to create a light fragrant cup.

Green Magic Tea (\$3)

Green tea from the Small Organic Farmers Association in Sri Lanka (Ceylon). It is a sweet and vegetal tea with a clean finish.

Fairly Traded Organic Hot Chocolate

Hot Cocoa Mix (\$5 for 12 oz.)

Just add hot water to make a rich and creamy cup. Produced in collaboration with La Siembra, a worker co-op in Canada, bringing together organic products from small-scale farmers in the Dominican Republic, farmer cooperatives in Paraguay, and U.S. dairy cooperatives.

Drinking Chocolate (\$6 for 13 oz.)

Using products from small-scale farmers in the Dominican Republic, Peru and Paraguay, this hot chocolate with a 57% cacao content is so chocolatey, it's like sipping a melted dark chocolate bar.

Spicy Hot Cocoa (\$5 for 12 oz.)

This deliciously spicy twist combines cocoa with cinnamon and cayenne pepper for cocoa with a kick! Uses organic products from small-scale farmers in the Dominican Republic and Paraguay.
